### **Applicants must fulfill the following scholarship requirements:**

1. Have completed at least 2 semesters of higher education
2. Have a 2.75/4.0 GPA
3. Be enrolled half time or more (at least six credit hours per semester)
4. Be pursuing an associate's, bachelor's, or graduate degree at Ball State University, Ivy Tech, Anderson University, Indiana Wesleyan University, or Taylor University
5. Provide a current unofficial transcript with the College/University name on it to the committee
6. Live in Delaware County full time

### **Criteria for the Awards**

Scholastic ability, industry, integrity, financial need, and the promise of being enabled by continuing education to become a leading citizen in the community, state and nation, as well as meeting the six requirements above, are consideration for these scholarships.

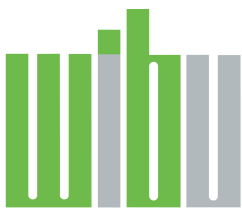
